

be paid into the hands of the Reiver General of this Province and the same shall be accounted for to His Majesty, his Heirs and Successors through the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury in such manner and form as His Majesty, his Heirs and Successors may direct.

XX. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that no suit or action shall be commenced or brought against any person offending against this Act unless the same shall be commenced or brought within three calendar months next after the offence committed and not afterwards.

XXI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid that this Act shall be deemed a public Act and shall be judicially taken notice of as such by all Judges Justices and other persons whomsoever without being specially pleaded.
