Following our last communication with our clients in London as to their selling the Mittord lands, we would be glad to know it you have any proposal to submit on behalf of your client.

to which we have replied as followed

"We have your letter of March 3rd and in pepty may say that we have not yet received instructions from the Department of Indian Affairs as to what offer about to made.

"We have a letter dated February 20th intimating that the matter is under review by the Department in Ottawa and as soon as we receive their further instructions, we will immediately communicate with you."

In connection with this matter, we would remind you that the lease between the Mitford Company and Grawford expired on December 31st last and strictly speaking there is no arrangement with respect to the acreage on which the leading pens and platforms are located, and it would appear to be desirable to some to some understanding as early as possible.
