			Harvard 3175 landed with wheels up on Main Aerodrome at approximately 2030 hours. The pilot, GB957175 LAC Horton, R.A. was not injured. Categorized Cl.	
	20-2-43		0800 hours C - 1000 feet, V - 2 miles. Wind 260/25. Dual. Flying washed in at 0830, out at 1200. $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours dual only. Aerodrome unserviceable in the P.M. Flying time 110 hours.	
	21-2-43		0900 C.A.V.U. Dual. Field spotty. Wind 320/5. 0900 flying washed in, washed out 1100 hours. 1530 flying washed in, 1815 hours washed out. $5\frac{3}{4}$ hours dual only. Flying time 157.05 hours Harvard 2869 nosed up when pilot swerved on landing at R.1 Edenvale at 1630 hours, and hit soft snow. The pilot, R141457 LAC Hornberger, F.J. was not injured. Categorized Cl. The pilot of Harvard 2638 overshot the aerodrome on landing, hit a soft spot on far boundary and the aircraft went up on nose. Accident occurred on Main Aerodrome at about 1030 hours. The pilot, Pilot Officer A.F. Badland, J14062, was not injured. Categorized Cl. R.C.A.F. Band Concert in Rexy Theatre, Barrie. LAW Roszell played two violin solos during the program. The concert was a decided success.
