I beg to say the Department of Indian Affairs requires a survey for one or two drains in the vicinity of Fixty-mine Corners to the Township of Tuecarors, Six Nations Indian Feserve, which work has been entrusted to you if you care to undertake the same. A blue print showing a sletch of the courses of these drains is enclosed. The Eastern main drain withits North and Couth Branche will probably be about four hundred rode in length. The Western main drain with its East and West Iranch will probably be about four hundred and fifty rods in length.

. Please interview the Indian Superintendent, Major Gordon J. Smith, of Brantford, and also the Indian Chiefs and Council regarding this work.

Please send in a plan and profile together with an assessment in the usual manner. You will obtain duly certified receipts and vouchers for all expenditures and send in your secount duly certified in duplicate. You may disregard the partial survey hade last year. If you care to undertake this work please notify the Department at your carliest convenience as it is desirable this work should be proceeded with as soon as possible.
