

In agencies where there are no Indian schools established and where Indian children attend white schools, reports regarding attendance, progress, etc., should be made. In any agency where Indian children attend white schools or institutions of higher learning, reference should be made to the matter.

As this report should reach the Department not later than March 1, 1916, it is hoped that you will lose no time in commencing its preparation. Last year a number of agents were negligent and as a result the completion of the Department's report was delayed. I trust that this will not occur this year.
