Sir,-

Referring to your letter of the 2nd instant, and previous correspondence, relative to your request to be allowed to enclose one-half of the verandah at the agency house at Bella Coola with wire screen in order to increase the bed room accommodation, I beg to say that if the work in question is done, it will be necessary for you to pay for it yourself. It is not reasonable for you to expect the Department to provide additional bed room accommodation at the agency house consequent upon the fact that your father-in-law and sister-in-law reside at your home.
