The Indians of your Agency should be induced if horticultural to exhibit along the lines of agricultural, and dairy motes, and you should do what you can to see that prizes for indian of the nature referred to, are offered. Kindly consult in the Mr. Anderson, Inspector of Indian Orchards in this matter before you see the Manager of the Agricultural Association.
