I asked her how long ago this was and she said not long ago. So I took her particulars her name was Hazel Lyon, driver in the A.T.S. Reception Camp, Silverton Cottage, Bordon, and she said that the man's name was J. Neilson and that he was from the R.C.A. I reported it to my Company Orderly Room. Considering that it was dark I identify Pte. H. Lyons as the person who made the complaint to me as above mentioned."

The accused declined to cross examine this witness.
