The Court. When the second soldier came down the stairs I could not say if he was carrying anything or not. My father was in the hall when the second soldier came down stairs. The accused (Sullivan) and the second soldier did not speak to one another. The B.S.M. came home after the Sgt. Caulonbe returned at 2:00 hrs. I saw the Sgt. Caulonbe return that evening but he did not have any things with him, I can definitely say that the soldier who came into the house went up stairs and then came down and I have not identified who it was. The accused was not the B.S.M. as he is taller. The accused Sullivan was wearing battle dress, and a leather jerkin.
