I saw the Sgt leave that evening but he did not have anything with him. I can definitely say that the soldier who came into the house went up stairs and then came down and I have not identified, was not the B. S. M. as he is taller. The accused Sullivan was wearing bottle dress, and a leather jerkin.
