SUBJECT: Disappearance - Taylorcraft BC12D Aircraft, CF-DBW - July 1st, 1957, between Langley & Penticton, B.C.

1. The following are the salient points concerning the subject disappearance:

- (a) DATE : July 1st, 1957;
- (b) CASUALTIES : (i) crew - pilot presumed killed;  
(ii) passengers - one presumed killed;
- (c) DAMAGE : (i) aircraft - unknown;  
(ii) third party - unknown
- (d) CAUSE : undetermined at this time - The cause of this accident appears to be the result of continuing VFR flight into unfavourable weather;
- (e) INFRACTIONS : unknown;
- (f) BLAME : unknown;
- (g) PUBLIC INTEREST : unknown;
- (h) RECOMMENDATIONS : further action is not recommended until the wreckage of the aircraft and the bodies have been located;
- (i) REMARKS : it would appear from information contained in weather reports on file that weather could be a factor in the disappearance of the subject aircraft.
