

XXVI.—Motions Put without Debate.

The following motions shall be put from the Chair without debate :—

1. To adjourn simply,
2. To the previous question.

XXVII.—Motions to Adjourn,—When in Order.

A motion to adjourn simply shall always be in order, except :—

1. In interruption of a member speaking.
2. When members are voting.
3. When to adjourn was the last preceding motion.
4. When it has been decided that the previous question shall be put.

XXVIII.—Quorum.

For annual and special meetings twelve members shall form a Quorum ; for Committee meetings three members shall form a Quorum. No meeting can transact business in the absence of a Quorum.

XXIX.—Appointment of Chairman.

At every meeting, as soon as it has been ascertained that a quorum is present, a Chairman shall be chosen from the members of the Association present.

XXX.—Duties of Chairman.

The Chairman shall, immediately after his election, take the Chair, call the meeting to order, and proceed with the order of business.

XXXI.—Absence of Secretary-Treasurer.
