

## RULES OF ORDER

The following Rules of Order shall be enforced during the transaction of all business and debates at all meetings of the Association.

(1) When the President takes the chair there shall be a general silence, and when the pass-word has been taken the meeting shall be open in due form.

(2) All motions must be seconded before they can be entertained.

(3) When a motion has been duly made and seconded the presiding officer shall state the same to the meeting before it can be debated.

(4) No motion shall be in order during debate on a question, except a motion to amend the question or adjourn.

(5) No member shall be interrupted while speaking, except to call him to order.

(6) No motion for re-consideration shall be in order unless moved and seconded by those who voted with the majority.

(7) Any person wishing to speak shall confine his remarks to the subject under debate.

(8) A motion to adjourn shall always be in order, and shall be decided without debate, and, if carried, the members shall keep their seats until the presiding officer has declared the meeting adjourned.

(9) Any member using foul language in any debate shall be liable to a fine of fifty cents, and, if repeated during the meeting, fined and expelled from the room.
