Members

XXIII.—Any ordinary member leaving the Province for one year or more may, on written application to the Secretary-Treasurer, and on payment of an annual fee of three dollars, become an absent member, and during his absence shall be exempt from the annual subscription. He shall be liable, however, to the payment of his quarterly subscription for the quarter in which he departs from the Province, and for that in which he returns to it.

Resignation
or Expulsion

XXIV.—Any member who shall withdraw, resign, or be expelled, or cease to be a member of the Club, shall forfeit *ipso facto* all right or claim thereon, or in or to its property or funds.

Amendment
or Alteration
of Club
Constitution

XXV.—The Constitution and Rules of the Club may be altered, amended, or repealed at any annual meeting of the Club, or any special meeting called for the purpose, by a vote of the majority of the members present at such meeting. Seven days' previous notice of any proposed alteration, amendment or repeal shall be given in writing, signed by at least five members of the Club, by posting the same in a conspicuous place in the Club rooms.

Strangers

XXVI.—Any member shall be allowed to introduce a stranger, but no person residing within twenty-five miles of the City shall be eligible to be introduced as a stranger or guest of a member. Any mem-
