Witness our " Trufty and Wellbeloved ALURED CLARKE, Esquire, Lieutenant "Governor and Commander in Chief of Our faid Province of Lower " Canada, at the Caitle of Saint Lewis, in Our City of Quebec, the "twenty fourth Day of May, in the Year of Our Lord, One " thousand seven hundred and ninety two, and the Thirty Second " Year of Our Reign." and the state of the second
