## **B**Y HIS **EXCELLENCY**

## SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, BARONET, L. L. D.

Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majefty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c.

THEREAS, the GENERAL Assembly of this Province, ftands prorogued to Thursday the Fourteenth day of November next:

I have therefore thought fit, by and with the advice of His Majefty's Council, further to prorogue the faid GENERAL ASSEMBLY, to Thursday the Twenty-eighth day of November next, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business : of which, all perfons concerned, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
