



PROCLAMATION.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY

SIR JOHN WENTWORTH, BARONET, L. L. D.

*Lieutenant-Governor and Commander in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-
Scotia, and its Dependencies, &c. &c. &c.*

WHEREAS, the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Province, stands prorogued to
Thursday the Fourteenth day of November next:

*I have therefore thought fit, by and with the advice of His Majesty's Council, further
to prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY, to Thursday the Twenty-eighth day of
November next, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business: of which, all persons
concerned, are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.*
