"those internal improvements which are absolutely requisite to give additional "facilities for the transit of the produce of the West to the Ocean. And this "House feels bound to declare that the absence of all reference to those subjects "will be considered by the People of this Province as a neglect by His Excel-"lency's advisers of what they consider measures of paramount importance," be added at the end of the second paragraph; the House divided: and the names being called for, they were taken down, as follow:—
