CONSUMERS' STRIKE ONTARIO LEGISLATURE... President McBride Does Not Fear Canadian Competition in Coal... COAL PRODUCTION SUSPENDED

COLEMAN, Ohio, April 21.—The great strike among the coal miners went into effect today at noon, according to the decree issued recently by the United Mine Workers.

President McBride of the United Mine Workers has the following statement to make: "The number of miners that are out and their distribution among the states: Pennsylvania, 30,000; Ohio, 30,000; Iowa, 6,000; West Virginia, 6,000; Tennessee and Kentucky, 5,000; Missouri, 3,000; Illinois, 2,000; Indiana, 2,000; Indian Territory, 2,000. The total is 123,000."
