### Camp Intoxicated,

The advices received would indicate that the shooting affray resulted from the group of logs behind which Tony Arosha and Leon Seppepil were in hiding when they fired the shots which ended the existence of Paddy Green and eventually their own lives, came, last evening, news of another shocking tragedy which will probably mean another murder trial in Victoria county.
