

PROGRAMME OF GUY Ter-Centenary CELEBRATION AT CUPIDS, Wednesday, August 17th, 1910.

His Excellency the Governor will arrive at Cupids from Harbour Grace on the "Fiona" during the forenoon, accompanied by H.M.S. "Brilliant."

Special train with Guy Celebration Committee and guests will arrive at 3 p.m.

His Excellency will make his official landing at 3.30 p.m., and will be received on the wharf by the Committee, after which all will proceed to the site of the Memorial.

An address of welcome will be presented to the Governor by Captain A. Smith, J.P., on behalf of the people of Cupids, to which His Excellency will reply.

Mr. McNeilly, K.C., will then deliver the Inaugural Address.

The Rev. W. Stacey, representing the Corporation of the City of Bristol, will formally present the Bristol Memorial Tablet, which will be accepted by the Rev. Canon Pilot, D.D., President of the Newfoundland Historical Society, who will invite His Excellency to unveil the Memorial.

The Memorial having been unveiled, a vote of thanks to His Excellency will be passed, on motion of the Colonial Secretary and the Rev. Charles Hackett.

The Governor will then proceed to the site of the flagstaff presented by the Toronto Committee. The flagstaff and flag will be presented by Professor W. G. Smith of Toronto, University, and will be accepted by Mr. R. J. Smith.

His Excellency will then hoist the flag and, if the regulations permit, a salute will be fired from H.M.S. "Brilliant."

During the ceremonies the Methodist Guards Band will play National airs at appropriate intervals.

A Concert will be held at 8.30 p.m. in the Orange Hall, under the patronage of His Excellency the Governor.
