Wei-Hai-Wei to Become Chinese Again, is Report

NO CASH DEMANDED. New York, Nov. 25.—The agreement providing for the restoration by Great Britain of Wei Hai Wei to China, the text of which was received yesterday rom Pekin, contemplates full Chinese administration with certain privileges reserved for the British navy.


The British navy is to be allowed to use a suitable anchorage for specific period, with the privilege of renewal. Some lands and buildings are to be leased back to the British navy for purposes of drilling and re-

Chinese maritime customs officers will collect dues and control the port as in other trading ports, part of the customs revenue to be used for the administration of the city as well as for the construction and upkeep of

Permanent leases held by foreigners in the territory will be changed into thirty year leases, with the privilege of another extension for a like period
