popularity of the Nova Scotia apple is rapidly growing in Europe. 1,103,980 barrels and 8,693 boxes were shipped in 1924-25 to ports in England, Scotland and Germany. Shipments also went to Newfoundland, West Indies, Central Canada

Production of sugar beets in Canada during 1923 amounted to 159,200 tons, valued at \$1,922,668, and grown on 17,941 acres, according to the Bureau of Statistics. 6,000 acres have been planted to beets this year in Southern Alberta, due to the establishment of a sugar beet factory.


