

A SET OF FINE STAMPS.

Mr. W. H. Schmalz, Berlin, has received from a private correspondent in the Tonga Islands, a complete set of their new postage stamps. The Tonga or Friendly Islands constitute a small kingdom near the Fiji Islands in the South Pacific, and their stamps are recognized by the philatelic authorities as the most handsome in existence. The complete set consists of thirteen stamps, ranging in value from a half penny to five shillings. The engraver has certainly produced beautiful work, and Mr. Schmalz is justly proud of the latest acquisition to his large and valuable collection.—*Berlin News Record.*
