The famous author is before us here not as a master of fiction but a writer on a devotional subject. The same attractive qualities are, however, apparent. The "upper room" is the spiritual chamber of the heart of man, and the lessons taught are directed to the Christian. A notable book in its class, and like'y to be much read.

THE SPIRIT-PILLED LIPE By Rev. John MacNell, B.A. Cloth, 75c. Fleming H. Revell Co., Toronto

"A simple, homely talk," says the author of this book. It is the product of a careful student of the Bible, and is filled with much that will help the teacher in the Sunday school or the parent in the home.

MUSICIANS AND THEIR COMPOSITIONS. By J. R. Orifiths. Cloth, 50c. Fleming H, Revell Co., Toronto

The writer is organist of Christ Church, London, and he presents a charming story of some of the masters of music—Hande', Bach, Haydn, Mozirt, Beethoven and Mendelssohn—with biographical data that read as well as many a telling romance. There are portraits and illustrations all through that are very pleasing. It is essentially a popular, not a technical, work. We should say it would sell well, in country or city.

THROUGH PRISON BARS, THE LIVES AND LABORS
OF JOHN HOWARD AND ELIZABETH FRY By

In these days of philanthropy—and the vast need of it—a popular little book on two of the most famous workers in prison reform will be acceptable. Prison reform is a live movement in Canada, since British prisons and treatment of criminals are not the only things requiring change. This book is most interesting, and the work of the great reformers is recalled with a sympathetic touch that is irresistible. For libraries and the home the volume will be in great demand.

LATER AMERICAN POEMS. Edited by J. E. Wetherell, B.A. Paper, with portraits. The Copp. Clark Co., Ltd., Toronto.

This is a charming collection of favorite pieces. The selections are made from noted modern poets, like Stedman, Winter, Aldrich, Howells, Father Ryan, Joaquin Miller, R. W. Gilder, Carleton, Eugene Field and many others. Many of the poems have an abiding place in the memories of this generation, and their being gathered together in this tasteful little volume will certainly be warmly appreciated.

A CHORD FROM A VIOLIN. By Winifred Agnes Haldane. Silv cloth, gilt top, 50c. Laird & Lee, Chicago

This little volume contains the autobiography of a rare old violin, which was sold to bring its master bread. It is taken to America,

and becomes the property of a young musician, whose sad career is beautifully told. Perhaps as tastefully told a love story as has come from the press in a long time.

CHRISTIANITY AND OUR TIMES. By R. P. Brorup. Paper, 23c. International Book Co.

This is a treatise in fifteen chapters on the moral and religious conditions of to-day rather than on theological dogmas. The book contains much that is practical and sensible with which all can agree. Some of its doctrines will not be accepted. Written mainly from the orthodox evangelical point of view, it launches a good many shafts at the Roman Catholic Church.
