The Churchwardens have issued a circular in reference to the Envelope System. It is very desirable that many more of our people should contribute in this way, that the Wardens may know more certainly what assured income may be relied upon. The Wardens are gratified that several have already responded to their appeal, but their numbers ought to be still further augmented.

Men, women and boys with willingness and ability to assist in leading the services of the church are urgently needed. Our excellent organist will give any such a hearty-welcome.
