

ST. LAURENT COLLEGE, Near MONTREAL.

THIS Institution, founded by the Rev. Fathers of the Holy Cross in 1847, and Incorporated by Act of Parliament in 1849, is empowered, by affiliation to Laval University, Qu'bec, to confer University Degrees. The course of Studies is divided into two Departments, Classical and Commercial. The Classical Department comprises six years, and embraces the different branches necessary to prepare young men for ecclesiastical Seminaries, or for any of the liberal professions, viz:—English Grammar, Arithmetic, Geography, Belles-Lettres, Rhetoric, Elocution, Ancient and Modern History; Latin, Greek, Botany, Natural History, Algebra, Geometry—plane, solid and spherical—, Trigonometry, Calculus, Geology, Zoology, Mineralogy, Natural Philosophy, Astronomy, Chemistry, Logic, Metaphysics,—general and special,—and Ethics.

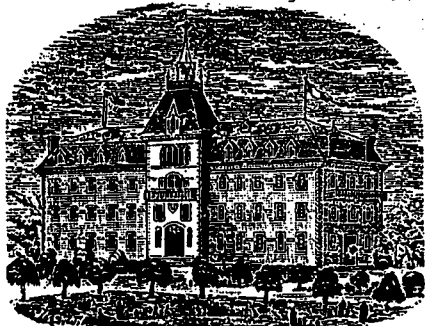
