HEATH MACQUARRIE, M.P., PROGRESSIVE CONSERVATIVE MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT FOR TORONTO-SPADINA AND QUEENS, P.E.I., RESPECTIVELY, WILL SERVE AS PARLIAMENTARY OBSERVERS ON THE CANADIAN DELEGATION TO THE TWELFTH SESSSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY.
