On motion of Mr. Rinfret, seconded by Mr. Caron, it was ordered,—That the name of Mr. Cameron (High Park) be substituted for that of Mr. Walker on the Standing Committee on External Affairs.

Mr. Chrétien, seconded by Mr. Guay, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-104, An Act to amend the Broadcasting Act, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Martin (Essex East), a Member of the Queen's Privy Council, laid before the House,—Copies of letters, dated between August 21 and October 3, 1963, exchanged between the Secretary of State for External Affairs and the Premier of the Province of Saskatchewan on the question of the possible diversion of water from the Columbia River basin to the Saskatchewan River under the terms of the Columbia River Treaty.
