133. All petitions for divorce and all Petitions, matters arising out of petitions for, or bills of to Comdivorce, shall be referred to the Standing mittee on Divorce. Committee on Divorce, and no reference to any Committee other than that Committee shall be necessary with respect to such petitions, bills and matters. B. 629, sq.

Notice of the day, hour and place of every Notice of meetings of sitting of the Committee shall be given by Committee. posting up the same in the lobby of the Senate not later than the afternoon of the day before the time appointed for such sittings, B. 630.

134. The Official Reporters of The Senate, Reporting and printing or one of them, when notified by the Chair- of evidence. man, shall be in attendance at each sitting of the Committee, and, having first been duly sworn to discharge faithfully such duty, shall take down in shorthand and afterwards extend the evidence of witnesses examined before the Committee, which evidence shall be printed under the supervision of the Clerk of the English Journals, B. 630.
