AND OTHER

RELIGIOUS BOOKS AND TRACTS.

The Book and Tract Committee of the Church Society has now open a depository in Toronto, for the sale of Bibles, Prayer Books, &c., on a larger scale than formerly. It is in the Book-store of Mr. Rowsell, King Street East, where specimens of all the Books on sale may be seen, which Mr. Rowsell's salesmen are engaged to sell to the Society's customers.

The Bibles, &c., are the best that can be obtained for their price, being from the Venerable Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge in London, England.

Amongst the Tracts are some in French and German, the latter of which may be obtained by any Clergyman of the Church applying for them. There are likewise German Bibles.

The sales, since the depository was made public, by placing it in Mr. Rowsell's Store in July last, have greatly increased. The amount disposed of at the end of October, has been 105 Bibles, 150 Testaments, 151 Prayer Books, 414 other Books, principally for Sunday Schools, and 1952 Tracts, including grants to various Missions made by the Church Society. This has nearly exhausted the supply of Prayer Books and Sunday School Books, but a fresh supply will be speedily ordered.

Subscribers of \$2.50 are entitled to a liberal reduction on the low prices charged to the public, and Clergymen making collections for the purpose are entitled to procure the Books, &c., at subscriber's prices.
