ALL GRAINS AT LOWER PRICES

Scattered Rains in Corn Belt Lead to Heavy Selling.

CHICAGO, Aug. 15.—Grain markets were lower all around. Corn, the largest item, was the centre of activity, continued to be the centre of activity. Net losses of 1-2 to 3-4 in wheat and 1-2 in oats. Provisions were 1-2 to 1-3 higher.

Damage From Rain.
In spite of some anxiety over possible damaging effects of too much rain in the Canadian northwest, wheat was on the downgrade nearly the entire session. An advance of 1-4 in Liverpool closing prices did not sustain the local market, and it sagged with corn. Prospects of increased wheat and flour equalled \$46,000 bushels.

Free selling of oats weakened prices after a good opening, and the market followed the dip in corn.

Investment buying and covering by shorts gave strength to provisions for most of the day, but at the close, free offerings caused recessions in most of the list.

CATTLE TRADE BARELY STEADY

Lambs Were Lower—Sheep and Calves Steady—Hogs Firm.

At the opening of the market yesterday there were 205 cars—3711 cattle, 671 hogs, 2802 sheep and lambs and 203 calves. At 11 a.m. there were 239 cars—1238 cattle, 775 hogs, 3435 sheep and lambs and 414 calves, which constitutes one of the largest deliveries of the season. There were many export cattle of good to choice quality, the best seen on the market for some time, but the number of good butcher cattle was not as large as usual.

There were very few calves for the day's market, and at the close there were a large number of calves, compared with last week, was about steady. London steers averaged \$12.00; Liverpool steers ten cent lower. Butchers' cattle, compared with last Tuesday's prices, were about steady. Sheep, calves and hogs were steady, while lambs were down 50c to 75c per lb. lower.

Exporters.
Swift & Co. sold 1000 head of 250 steers for London, 1281 lbs. each, at \$6.75; also 250 steers for Liverpool, 1290 lbs. each, at \$6.50, which was a low price for last week.
