## INTERPRETATION.

2. (1) In this Act, Definitions. (a) "analyst" means a person designated as an analyst "Analyst." under the Food and Drugs Act or under this Act; (b) "marihuana" means Cannabis sativa L.; "Marihuana." (c) "Minister" means the Minister of National Health 5 "Minister." and Welfare: (d) "narcotic" means any substance included in the "Narcotic." Schedule or anything that contains any substance included in the Schedule; (e) "opium poppy" means Papaver somniferum L.; "Opium (f) "place" includes any vehicle, vessel, railway car or poppy. "Place." aircraft: (g) "possession" means possession as defined in the "Possession." Criminal Code; and 15 (h) "traffic" means "Traffic." (i) to manufacture, sell, give, administer, transport, send, deliver or distribute, or (ii) to offer to do anything mentioned in subparagraph (i) otherwise than under the authority of this Act or the 20 regulations. (2) For the purposes of this Act, a person who occupies, Possession controls, or is in possession of any place in or upon which of place. any narcotic is found shall be deemed to be in possession thereof, unless he proves that the narcotic was there without 25 his authority, knowledge or consent. OFFENCES AND PUNISHMENTS. 3. (1) Except as authorized by this Act or the regula-Possession of tions, no person shall have a narcotic in his possession. narcotic. (2) Every person who violates subsection (1) is guilty Offence. of an offence and is liable 30 (a) upon summary conviction to imprisonment for a term of not less than six months and not more than eighteen months; or (b) upon conviction on indictment to imprisonment for a term of not less than six months and not more than 35 seven years. 4. (1) Except as authorized by this Act or the regula-Trafficking in narcotics. tions. (a) no person shall traffic in a narcotic or any substance represented or held out by him to be a narcotic; and (b) no person shall have in his possession any narcotic

for the purpose of trafficking.
