Meetings of  
Council.

6. There shall be two regular meetings of the Council in each year, one to be held during the annual meeting of the Association, and one on the third Tuesday in April.

Special  
Meetings of  
Council.

7. Special meetings may be called by the President or Chairman.

Notice to be  
given by Secre-  
tary.

8. Due notice of every such meeting shall be given by the Secretary to each member of the Council.

Constitution of  
quorum.

9. At any meeting of the Council when business relating to the property or to the financial affairs of the Association is transacted, five members shall form a quorum; for the transaction of any other business three shall form a quorum.

Annual Report  
of Council.

10. The Council shall make a report of the affairs of the Association at the Annual Meeting, which report shall include the report of the Secretary and also of the Board of Examiners.

Board of Exam-

11. The Board of Examiners shall make a report to the Council at the Annual Meeting of the Association in each year.

12. The Standing Committees shall be as follows: Each shall be composed of not less than 5 and not more than 9 members.

13. Each Standing Committee appointed by the Council shall endeavor to advance the interests of the Association in that branch allotted to it.
