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The Parliament Buildings

BRITISH Columbians are quite justly proud of their Parliament Buildings. Surmounted by the gilded figure of Captain Vancouver (after whom Vancouver Island is named), they occupy a striking situation amid lawns and flower-beds. The central or main portion alone appears in the picture. Out of sight to the left is the Museum, and to the right the Printing Office. Behind is the Library, and to the rear will be found the Mineralogical Museum housed in the old Legislative Building.
