OF THE
QUEBEC
DISPENSARY.

THE Objects of this Institution are to afford Medical Relief to Sick and Diseased Poor, to give attendance on Poor Lying-in Women, at their own houses, and to inoculate Children for the Cow Pox.

For these purposes, attendance will be given every day, (Sundays excepted) at the Dispensary, from Twelve to One o'clock, where Advice and Medicines will be given to all Patients applying in person, on their presenting a recommendation from a Subscriber, or from the Curate or Clergyman of the Parish or Congregation to which they belong; and those, whose situation may require it, will be visited in their own houses.

On being cured or dismissed, Patients will receive a letter of Thanks at the Dispensary; to be signed by them, and delivered to the person who had recommended them.

Poor Lying-in Women, similarly recommended, or in cases of sudden emergency, without recommendation, will be attended, on application being made at the hours of Visit, at the Dispensary, or at other hours,

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
