

COBALT---Silver Stocks Are Strongly Despite Weakness Elsewhere---COBALT

TO MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS IN REGARD TO CAR FENDERS CAN GET A CONFERENCE WITH THE MANUFACTURERS TRADING IS NOT ACTIVE BUT PRICES ARE FIRM

Result of Attendance of A. B. Ingram at Big Convention

A. B. Ingram, vice-chairman of the municipal and railway board, returned yesterday from Columbus, Ohio, where he attended the American Street and Inter-urban Railway Association. The meetings were held from the 16th till the 19th, inclusive, and were attended by 400 delegates. Mr. Ingram was much impressed with the thoroughness and completeness of the organization, every phase of railway construction and management being illustrated. There were associations for the different sections, such as the accountants, superintendents, engineers, manufacturers, and so forth. Models of cars, brakes, fenders and other equipment were displayed, and a model track, laid by the Carnegie people, was exhibited.

Mr. Ingram stated that he would have some recommendations to make to the board as a result of his visit, one of which would be about fenders. The continuous rail to another point which attracted attention, and demonstrations were given of the welding of steel rails in 15 seconds.

ISSUES IN SHELBURNE.

The Transcript has a dispatch from Montreal which says: "A small-sized sensation has been caused in political circles here by the attack made on R. L. Borden and other leading Conservatives in the manifesto in support of Dr. Weldon's candidature in Shelburne County and recently published in the Halifax Herald. It has been understood that the fact of the party here who are promoting the candidature of Dr. Weldon has been after Fielding for some time, but it was not expected that it would assume the violence contained in the manifesto. No one cares to assume responsibility for the manifesto, but there is a strong impression that it is, if not wholly prepared, at least inspired by Dr. Weldon himself. The announcement is made on behalf of Dr. Weldon all over the country that the contest will be fought out on the two issues of the autonomy legislation and seasonal indemnity."

This deputation desired The World to state that the strike was still on, and that the strikers thought that the public should be apprised of this fact. The chief grievance they have is that the piano and organ manufacturers will pay no attention to the different sections, such as the accountants, superintendents, engineers, manufacturers, and so forth. Will Not Stop Property.

D. A. Cobalt, Oct. 22.—The provisional directors of the Cobalt City Mining Company have decided to lease the town site, now owned by the Ontario Land Office, to the town of Cobalt, and comprises about 40 acres.

Cumberland-Edly Copper Mine.

The main facts regarding Cumberland-Edly Company are as follows: It was incorporated under the laws of Ontario, and has an authorized capital of 1,000,000 shares, of which 500,000 are now outstanding. It was two properties in the Edly camp, aggregating 1200 acres. One of these adjacent Nevada Consolidated on the east, and the other Giroux Consolidated on the west. Both properties have been developed to the extent of 1000 feet tunnels, and it is now fairly well established that they contain ore similar to that in the Nevada Consolidated mine. The company is controlled by the same interests as Nevada, the Guggenheims, and measures have recently been taken whereby it will acquire the 1000-foot tunnel, 10,000-ton smelter about to be erected, and in the railroad of 120 miles connecting the camp with the Pacific coast.
