## GIVE TURKEY NO TIME EXTENSION ON PEACE PACT

Boulogne Conference Decides Reply Must Be Made June 26.

### LETTER TO GERMANY

Premiers Will Insist On Germans Complying With Terms of Versailles Treaty.

BOULOGNE, June 21.—(By the Associated Press.)—Turkey will not be given an extension of time to consider the peace treaty, according to a communiqué given out by the delegates after their return from the conference at 5:30 o'clock tonight. The communiqué says: "The Turkish question has been considered, and it has been decided to maintain the date of June 26 for Turkey to submit her reply to the peace conditions."

ULTIMATUM TO GERMANY.  
BOULOGNE, June 21.—(By the Associated Press.)—The conference of the premiers will tonight or tomorrow send to Germany a letter demanding execution of the clauses of the treaty of Versailles relating to disarmament. The text will not be given out until it is received in Berlin, but the letter is understood to be a categorical refusal to allow Germany to maintain an army of 200,000 men. This letter, which Marshal Foch and Field Marshal Wilson finished drafting at their hotel while most of the delegates attended a picnic lunch, was taken up by the council immediately upon reconvening this afternoon. The conference also discussed reparations and the Turkish situation at this session, which was prolonged until a late hour.

## Toronto Firm Guilty, Opinion Board To Give

Commerce Board To Submit Sugar Case To Ontario Attorney-General.

OTTAWA, June 21.—(By Canadian Press.)—The board of commerce will shortly submit to the attorney-general of Ontario its opinion that the firm of H. B. Eckhardt & Co. of Toronto are guilty of an offence under section 17 of the combines and fair prices act by keeping in stock an unreasonable amount of granulated and yellow sugar beyond what is reasonable for the purposes of business, and also in selling the sugar at gross profits of approximately 13.8 per cent in the case of the granulated sugar and 22.6 per cent on sales of yellow sugar.

## AYR MAN ARRESTED ON ARSON CHARGE

Alleged To Have Confessed To Setting Fire To Factory.

GALT, June 21.—A report, believed to be well founded, but so far impossible to confirm, was received here this afternoon, that investigators of the fire marshal's department had solved the disastrous blaze of a week ago at the John Watson plant, Ayr, which resulted in a loss of \$175,000, by the arrest of a married man of that village. The man is reported to have confessed to setting the building on fire after he had taken some tools away, with which he broke into the Ramsay store and stole a lot of merchandise, some of which, it is said, was found in his home.

## DRURY GOVERNMENT WILL NOT INTERFERE IN HYDRO DISPUTE

Rollo Says Government Did Not Authorize Shutting Down Operations.

TORONTO, June 21.—So far the Drury Government has shown no disposition to interfere with the situation on the hydro construction between Queenston and Chippewa, where the provincial hydro commission has ordered a close-down owing to labor difficulties. Rumors that the labor wing of the Government might make trouble and possibly disrupt the coalition do not appear to have any foundation. While labor stands on the eight-hour day, which is at issue at Chippewa and the U. F. O. is not keen for the eight-hour day, the labor ministers say they have had no representations made to them by the I. L. P. members inside or outside of the House.

## MISSING MOTORBOAT TURNS UP SAFELY

DETROIT, June 21.—A motor boat carrying a party of eleven Detroiters, who it was feared, had perished in Sunday's heavy sea on Lake St. Clair, reached Mount Clemens in safety today after being driven ashore and spending the night near Algona. Police boats and aeroplanes swept the lake today in search of the missing launch.

Not a Wheel Turning On Huge Chippewa-Queenston Canal.

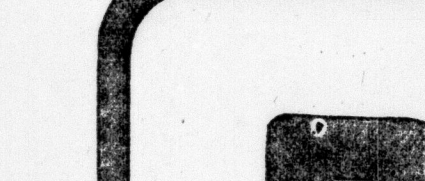
### HOPE IN CONFERENCE
