## LIBERALS OPPOSE PROTEST AGAINST CHARLES CALDER

Only a Small Section of the Party in South Ontario Cares to Have It Made.

Pickering, Feb. 27.—(Special).—A commotion was perceptible in the local political camp on Saturday night, when the Pickering contingent to the Liberal meeting at Whitby returned and announced that a protest against Mr. Calder's election would not, likely be entered. Many of the staunchest Liberals in this section are decidedly opposed to entering a protest. They maintain the party leaders have allowed the new government to be returned without opposition, and have decided to enter no protest, thus giving the Whitney government all the chance it needs and reserving their own strength for a united front four years hence.

One old-time Liberal was pleased that now his conscience was no longer troubled by having voted against Mr. Dryden and the Ross government. He said it was time for a change when the Liberal faction, led by Richardson, Goomley, Vanstone and Stanley pointed the finger of scorn against their neighbors. Mr. Dryden had bid farewell to his old constituency, but a counter protest would, no doubt, be entered, and his name would be dragged once more through the mud.

He was satisfied that if the new government issued a royal commission to enquire into the elections of 1898 and 1902, many Liberals who, like himself, had voted against their party for their party's good, and were perfectly satisfied with what they had done, would, by lifting the curtain, resent this assumption of the custodianship of the party conscience by men who have figured prominently before the court in former trials and who might again figure if such royal commission were appointed.

It is expected that each polling subdivision will contribute \$25 or \$30 toward the costs. ## AUTOMOBILE SHOW OPENS

Forty Cars Exhibited

Attractive Display of 1905 Models, the Product of Eleven Different Manufacturers.

The annual Toronto automobile show opened on Monday night at the show-rooms and garage of the Canada Cycle and Motor Company, at Temperance and Bay-streets. A good crowd attended on the opening night, and the show-rooms were filled with the latest models of the year. There are about 40 cars on exhibition, the product of 11 different factories. ## LEGISLATURE CANNOT REGULATE THE HOURS

of Labor on Sunday, Says Supreme Court.

Ottawa, Feb. 27.—The Supreme Court has decided that a provincial legislature has not the power to regulate the hours of labor on Sunday. The court this morning, with the exception of Judge Idington, who refrained from giving any reply, decided three of the questions submitted to it by the Dominion government and the province in the negative. Those questions are as follows:

(1) Has the legislature of a province authority to enact a statute in the terms of the annexed draft bill? (2) Is the provision of the draft bill, in so far as it relates to the prohibition of work on Sunday, beyond the jurisdiction of a province in part only, (a) which of the sections or which of the provisions thereof are ultra vires, and (b) to what extent are they ultra vires? (3) Upon the repeal of consolidated statute of Upper Canada, chapter 104, would it be competent to the legislature of Ontario to enact the said draft bill in its entirety, or in part, (a) in so far as it relates to the prohibition of work on Sunday, and (b) to what extent?

The remaining questions the majority of the court did not answer at all. Judge Sedgewick and Idington dissented. Answered in the Negative. Judge Nesbitt returned a negative reply to those questions which were as far as the jurisdiction of the province is concerned.

(4) Has a province jurisdiction to legislate prohibiting or regulating labor so as to prevent any work, business or labor from being performed within the province upon the first day of the week, commonly called "Sunday," except work of necessity, of mercy, and except work of labor of a character and to the extent contemplated in section 2 of the said draft bill? (5) Has a province power to restrict the operations of companies of its own creation to six days in each week by the prohibition of work on Sunday, or of any of the provisions of the Dominion or any of them, and, if so, to what extent, and to what extent are they ultra vires, and (b) to what extent are they ultra vires?

(6) Are the following classes of companies or corporations created by the Dominion or any of them, and, if so, to what extent, and to what extent are they ultra vires, and (b) to what extent are they ultra vires?
