The North American Mails are made up in London on the 3d and 18th of every month, except when either of these days fall on Sunday. when they will be postponed till next day. Steam Packets will start from Liverpool the next afternoon after the arrival of the London In November, December, January and February, there will be but one Mail in each month, that of the 3d. They will sail for Boston in a few hours after their arrival at Halifax. They will also leave Boston on the 1st and 16th of every month, when those days do not fall on Sunday, and then on the following day-in the winter months above named, only one Mail will be despatched from Boston, that of the 1st, and from Halifax, on the 3d.
