formation given, and for the counsel and encouragement contained therein. We direct that it be printed in the minutes; and also recommend that it be read in each of our First-day meetings. See appendix.

VII. The representatives are directed to bring to our next session the names of friends to act as Clerk and Assistant Clerks for the ensuing year. Also the names of three Friends from each Quarterly Meeting to act as a Standing Committee during the sessions of the Yearly Meeting.
