Unique Tablet to be Unveiled at Fredericton in Honor of War Heroes.

Names of Twelve Fallen Are Perpetuated in Tribute to be Unveiled Sunday.

Fredericton, N. B., Nov. 15—A memrial tablet in memory of the young
chi of Christchurch Cathedral, who
for their lives in the Great War, is
being erected at the Cathedral and
will be unveiled on Sunday morning
each by His Lordship Bishop Richardton.

The tablet is of bronze, surmounted by a cross of stone, set in the pillar on the south side of the chancel over the Dean's stall. The cross is made from pieces of stone brought from France by His Lordning Bishop Richardson on his visit to the battlefields of France. The pieces have been cut in the form of a cross and surmount the bronze tablet.

The inscription is as follows: "This

The inscription is as follows: "This cross is made of stones brought from the ruins of the Lady Chapel Altar and the high altar of the Cathedral of Arras, and from the ruins of the high altar and of the nave in the Cathedral of Ypres, respectively, by the Rt. Rev. John A. Richardson, third Bishop of Fredericton, in February, 1918, and has been set into this pillar in honor of the men of this cathedral who laid down their lives in the Great War in the cause of freedom, and whose names are here gratefully recorded by their fellow-members in the congregation."

Directly underneath are the names of the honored dead: Albert Morris, perian A. Thompson, Lawrence S. Starman, Rainsford Winslow, Percy W. Grant, W. Geoffrey Bidlake, Harry T. Spare, Jasper A. Winslow, Allen R. Wetmore, Robert Morris, John W. Charney Morris, Lawrence Webster.

At the foot of the tablet are the words: "Greater love hath no man than this, that, a man lay down his life for his friends."

Three of the young men who gade their lives and whose names are on the memorial tablet—Albert Morris, Robert Morris and J. W. Charney Morris—were brothers, being sons of Mr. and Mrs. Robert Morris, of Campbell street, this city.
