REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE OF THE DIOCESAN SYNOD ON SUNDAY SCHOOLS.

The tabular forms for Sunday Schools, adopted at the last Synod, and sanctioned by the Lord Bishop, have been sent to all the clergy. Fifty returns have been received, from which the following statistics are drawn :—

ABSTRACT OF REPORT ON SUNDAY SCHOOL STATISTICS IN THE DIOCESE OF TORONTO, FOR THE YEAR 1864.

Although the Table of Statistics which has been prepared, shewing the condition of the Sunday Schools in the Diocese, for 1864, embrace a great variety of details, it has not been thought advisable to do more in this report than to present to the Synod a brief abstract of the summary of the statistics which has been made up from the returns which have been received up to late last night.

The total number of parishes and missions, out of ninety-two in the Diocese, from which reports have been received is fifty ; and the following are the principal items which it has been thought desirable to present in this abstract, viz. :—
