**Former Galt Man
Prominent Author**

The Galt Reporter referring to a former Galt man, now a noted author says:
"We get a glimpse into the life of a famous author in a letter written by Dr. John Beattie Crozier, of London, England, to 'The Librarian of the Galt Mechanics' Institute' and received this week by Miss Millard of the Carnegie Public Library.
"The Wheel of Wealth" is Dr. Crozier's latest book, and one of his best judging by the eulogistic notices it has received from the ablest of the British critics. He is sending a copy of the same to Galt. This is his letter:
"With the compliments of the author to the Old Librarian, to which he owed so much when he was a boy at Tassie's School, and afterwards, and which laid the foundation of any good which the author has done in England since by his books, and of which he has ever since retained the most affectionate and grateful regards, and especially now that he is old and blind, and desolate from the recent loss of his dear wife."
The handwriting is Dr. Crozier's and the old-time clearness is not absent from the penmanship, though sightless eyes faded the pages before him as he used the pen to open his heart to some persons in far-

off Galt, the home of his youth and early struggles. Dr. Beattie Crozier became an intellectual when scarcely out of his teens and in the great literary market of the world has been acclaimed one of the profoundest scholars of the day. Among his books "Civilization and Progress" and "History of Intellectual Development" are especially favored. "The Wheel of Wealth" has not yet reached the Public Library.
Dr. Crozier's reference to 'The Librarian of the Galt Mechanics' Institute suggests to The Reporter that he would be delighted to hear that the Carnegie Library, its successor, is the rendezvous of scores of pupils from the Collegiate Institute, located on the site of the old Tassie School—and doing valuable work in training the youth of the city and district much as he was trained in the sixties under Dr. Tassie.

The Crozier home, as some of the readers will remember, is the Burns' like cottage on Calhoun street, adjacent to the residence of Dr. Radford.

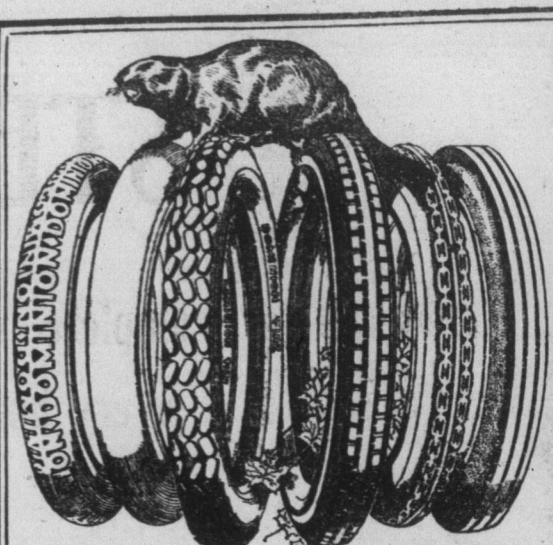
