TOGOLESE MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS AND COOPERATION TO VISIT CANADA

The Honourable Jean-Luc Pepin, Minister for External Relations, announced today that His Excellency Mr. Anani Kuma Akakpo-Ahianyo, Minister of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation of the Togolese Republic, will be in Canada on an official visit from March 28 to 30, 1984. Mr. Akakpo-Ahianyo will be accompanied by His Excellency Mr. Barry Moussa Barque, Minister of Public Works, Energy, Mines and Water Resources. Mr. Akakpo-Ahianyo will be in Ottawa on March 28 to meet with Mr. Pepin and other representatives of the Canadian Government. He will then proceed to Quebec and to Calgary to meet with representatives of these Provincial Governments. Discussions in Ottawa are expected to concentrate on bilateral relations and an exchange of views about recent developments on the African continent.
