Was Reeve of Hawkesbury for four years, and Warden of the United Counties of Prescott & Russell for three years. Sat for Inkermann in Leg. Council, Can., from 1860 until the Union. HAMILTON, *Hon* John. C.

B. in Canada. Has been Chairman and is one of the Trustees of the University of Queen's College, Kingston. Was at one time President of the late Commercial Bank. Has been President of the Canadian Inland Steam Navigation Company since its incorporation. Sat in Leg. Council, Can., as a life Mem. from June, 1841, until the Union. Called to the Senate, May, 1867.—*Kingston, Ont.*

HAZEN, *Hon.* Robert Leonard, Q. C.

Called to the Bar, N. B., Oct., 1832. Is Judge and Commissary of the Court of Vice-Admiralty, N. B., and Recorder of the city of St. John, N. B. Was a mem. of Ex. Council, N. B., from 1844 to 1855, and again from 1857 to 1858. Was a mem. of the Leg. Council, N. B., before the Union. Called to the Senate, May, 1867.—*St John. N. B.*
