## An Act to remove doubts as to legitimacy of the children of the late Jean Baptiste Gatien and Monique Audon.

TATHEREAS the late Jean Baptiste Gatien in his life time, of the Parish Preamble. V of Ste. Philomene, in the District of Montreal, Yeoman, and the late Marie Audon, both died in the said Parish, after having cohabited for a period of fifty-six years, and lived as man and wife, and after having had several children; and whereas doubts have arisen as to validity of their marriage and the legitimacy of the children, issue of the same, in conscournee of their being unable to precure certificates of the said marriage, and it is just to remove these doubts and to maintain the said children in the possession of the estate and property of their said parents; There-10 forc Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:
