

10. [The Company may acquire, erect and maintain such piers, wharves, tramways, storehouses, and other facilities for the proper handling and care of freight and passengers as the directors from time to time determine.]

5 **11.** The Company may construct, equip, work and maintain a telegraph line and telephone lines along the whole length of its railway and branches, and may establish offices for the transmission of messages for the public; and for the purpose of erecting and working such telegraph and telephone lines,
10 the Company may enter into a contract with any other company.

12. The Company may enter into arrangements with any other telegraph or telephone Company for the exchange and transmission of messages, or for the working in whole or in
15 part of the lines of the Company.

13. If the construction of the railway described in section 7 of this Act is not commenced within three years after the passing of this Act, or if the railway is not finished and put in operation within five years after the passing of this
20 Act, then the powers conferred upon the Company by Parliament shall cease and be null and void as respects so much of the railway as then remains uncompleted.
