The Right Honourable W. L. Mackenzie King, Prime Minister of Canada, Ottawa, Ontario.

Dear Mr. King:

I am enclosing herewith a form of Agreement suggested by my Government in connection with the Natural Resources question. You will see that the Alberta agreement has been substantially adhered to. Sections 21, 22 and 23 are new sections and refer to the period between 1870 and 1905. As you know our House is in session and we would like to have the necessary legislation brought down before prorogation.

If this agreement is satisfactory would you kindly wire me and we shall arrange to adjourn the House on Friday, February 28th. We could reach Ottawa by Sunday night, March 2nd, and if convenient could go into conference with your Government on Monday and Tuesday, March 3rd and 4th.
