No. 26. George Gordon's Band. Kindly quote the authority for transfer. Unless the consent of the Band to transfer was and secured, this boy will have to be paid in future with Muscowequans Band under No. 111.

No. 79. Goerge Gordon's Band. The note in the case of No.
